The Protocol exists between the areas in Pan- Hampshire (Hampshire, Isle of Wight, Portsmouth and Southampton).	The protocol provides information on how to share information and work with other Local Authorities when children move and they are subject to statutory orders, including:
Whilst the detail of the protocol is more focussed	
on the actions and responsibilities of children's social care, the principles of timely and proactive information sharing are relevant and necessary for staff from all agencies. Where specific action from other agencies is needed this is referenced in the protocol.	<ul> <li>A full care order</li> <li>An interim care order</li> <li>Any form of supervision or family assistance order</li> <li>An emergency protection order</li> <li>A child assessment order</li> <li>Subject to current use of police protection powers</li> </ul>

In addition the protocol provides further information on the expectations of all agencies to share information when children move and:

- One or more of their parents is a care leaver
- The child(ren) are subject to child protection planning
- Transfer/ sharing of information between authorities
- Transfer in conference
- Sharing information when children move temporarily
- A Child with a Child Protection Plan is about to leave the Country
