<b>Agency name</b>	<b>HAMPSHIRE HOSPITALS FOUNDATION TRUST MATERNITY SERVICE</b>
<b>Our role / responsibility</b>	To deliver antenatal, intrapartum, and postnatal care to women and families including National Screening Programme and Public Health intervention.
<b>Information we contribute to the conference</b>	Clinical, social, and complex needs information pertaining to women, unborn/newborn babies and their families seen in the service.
<b>Information we do not have access to or contribute to the conference</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Police and children's social care information regarding previous intervention.</li> <li>• Information on older children which may contribute to risk.</li> <li>• School information for previous children.</li> <li>• Probation and substance misuse service information for unidentified adults.</li> <li>• Unborn baby's father or mother's partner's mental health background which may contribute to risk.</li> </ul>
<b>How we contribute and why</b>	<p>Provide a report and attend Child Protection Conference (CPC) in person.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide a report on pregnancy, unborn baby's and newborn's current clinical status.</li> <li>• Provide insight to impact of parental behaviour on the outcome of pregnancy.</li> <li>• History of engagement with the service which will impact risk to unborn</li> <li>• Evidence of current contacts with the family.</li> <li>• Information based of mother's views on pregnancy and insight into risk.</li> <li>• Gather information to inform pre and post birth planning.</li> </ul>
