

# HIPS CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE STRATEGY AND TOOLKIT LAUNCH



Hampshire, Isle of Wight, Portsmouth and Southampton (HIPS) Safeguarding Children Partnerships will launch the new Child Sexual Abuse Strategy and associated online toolkit on 28th March 2023 to support professionals working with young people and their families in the Hampshire and Isle of Wight areas.

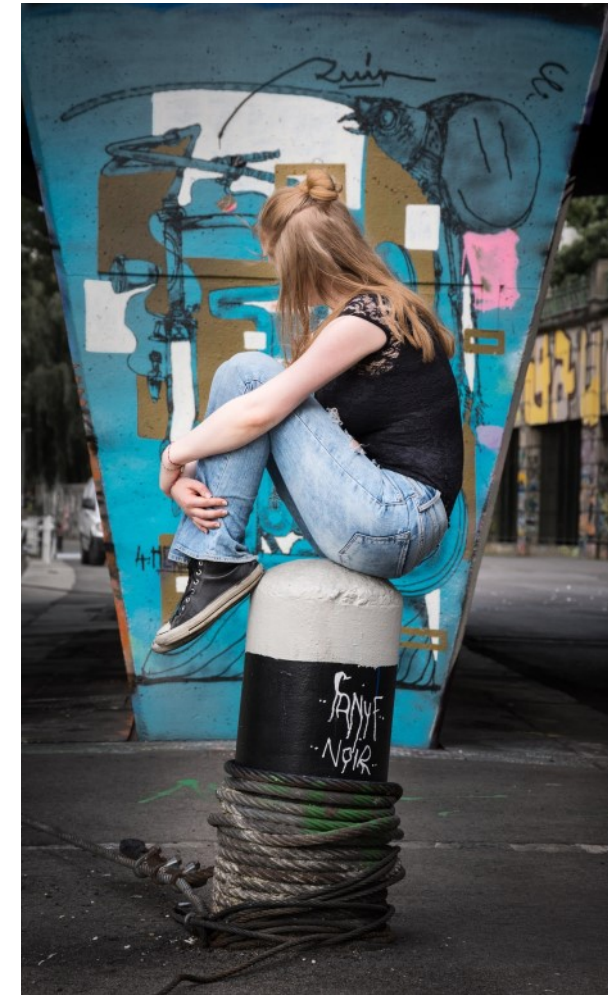
This strategy has been produced to support a co-ordinated approach to preventing child sexual abuse (CSA), and improve the identification, protection, and support for victims, survivors, and their families. It has been created to improve the ways in which children's needs and risks are understood, recognised and responded to at all stages.

The launch will be held via three Teams Live webinars, *Child Sexual Abuse Strategy and Toolkit Launch*, which are scheduled for Tuesday 28th March, at 9.30am-11.30am, 1pm-3pm and a twilight session at 6.30pm-8.30pm.

Attendance from partner agencies across the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Safeguarding Children Partnerships is encouraged. Learning will be relevant for professionals from operational to senior management roles.

Delegates attending the free launch event will achieve the following learning outcomes:

- Introduce the Child Sexual Abuse Strategy and Toolkit.
- How the Strategy and Toolkit will support professional practice.
- Share learning from local cases.
- Explore how key messages can be disseminated and opportunities for further training
