Hampshire's Reducing Parental Conflict offer

We are launching the new Strengthening Parental Relationships online toolkit for professionals and parents and carers on 27th April 2023 to support professionals working with young people and their families in the Hampshire area.

There is strong evidence that conflict between parents/ carers – whether together or separated – can have a significant negative impact on children's mental health and long-term life chances. While all relationships will experience conflict, it is when conflict is frequent, intense and poorly resolved that it can be damaging to children.

The Toolkit provides information and resources to support parents/ carers strengthening their relationships including free courses for parents/ carers, practical tools for professionals and examples of evidence based best practice.
